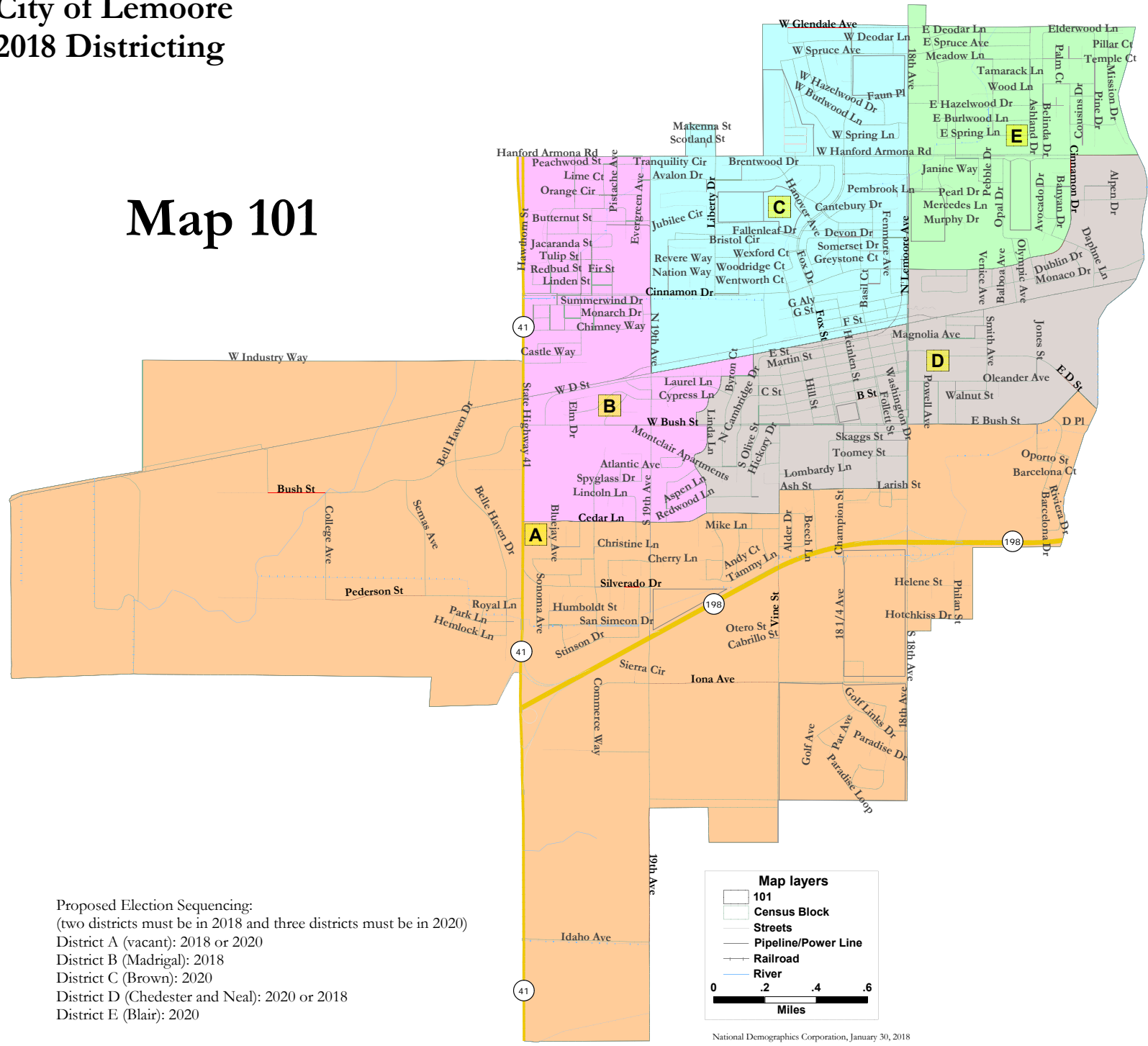


City of Lemoore 2018 Districting
